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

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A BEEF STROGANOFF RECIPE BY SOMEONE WHO HATES YOUR GUTS

SATIRE By Elliott Weix Ingredients: Beef. 0.45 kg Butter. 9.86 mL Onions, chopped. 2 Flour. 7.81 g Paprika. 4.54 g Water. 946.35 mL Garlic, finely chopped. 3 metric cloves Mushrooms, chopped. 0.45 kg Egg noodles. 0.45 kg Sour cream. 118.29 mL Mustard. 44.36 mL Salt and Pepper. To taste Chop the beef into 2.7 centimeter pieces and season generously with salt and pepper, and your own tears. Melt half the butter in a large saucepan on enough heat to give you a first-degree burn. Cover the bottom of the pan with the meat. You may need to cook the meat in two batches, depending on the size of the pan and how much you suck at cooking. Brown the meat on all sides, and remove it from the pan when finished. Add the onions to the pan and sauté. Sprinkle with the flour and paprika. Drop the meat back in the pot. Cover it with a lid, but leave it askew so the steam can escape. Wow. they shrink (just like everyone's expectations of you). Cook the noodles according to package instructions before you remember there's a better way to do it but it's already too late and the noodles are sticking together and this whole recipe is falling apart just like your life. Woman Finds a Canine Surprise After Returning From Trip By: Jonathan Buscher

After receiving news on January 5, 2022 that one of her dogs, Fran, had gone missing, Liz Giorgi rushed to her home in Denver, Colorado, taking five days as she was overseas for a funeral. Before leaving on her trip, Giorgi had left the care of her two dogs with Wag, a dog-walking and pet-sitting service. Then, in another turn of events, about a week after Fran had been reported missing, Giorgi received an automated and unemotional call from Wag which informed her that her dog had passed away, stating that these instances are rare, but do occasionally happen, as well as asking for additional questions. Devastated by this, Giorgi returned to Twitter, warning others not to use Wag, and waiting for an apology in a post tagging Garrett Smallwood, the CEO of Wag. This isn't the first time something like this has happened either, with a June 2019 report of a stolen dog by the dog-walking company, and a lawsuit from an LA couple whose French Bulldog was killed by an SUV under Wag's watch.

A Priceless Graffiti Masterpiece ^{By: JB}

Along with a date reading Dec. 26, 2021, a rock at Texas' Big Bend National Park was engraved with the four names: Issac, Ariel, Norma, and Adrian. This was no ordinary boulder either, but a piece of volcanic rock dating more than 30 million years old, and considered a petroglyph, having been engraved between 4,000 to 8,500 years ago by a Native American artist. Not only was this vandalism damaging, but a later attempt by a visitor to fix the issue resulted in further deterioration of the stone. Their use of tap water introduced chlorine, staining the petroglyph white and making the issue even more difficult for experts to reverse. While the National Park Service has tried to use both a fine brush and distilled, rather than tap, water to remove the stain and scratches, the damage has been dealt, and NPS is now asking the public to look for the offenders, who could face up to \$5,000 in fines and six months prison time as a penalty. This isn't the

first time an act of egregious vandalism has happened at Big Bend either, being the fiftieth instance since tracking began in 2015. Responses by park staff to this violation of property have been rather negative as well, with Superintendent of the park, Bob Krumenaker stating that "With each instance of vandalism, part of our nation's heritage is lost forever," in regards to the priceless loss of a piece of history.



Elon Musk Reveals Plans for Sun Colonization By: Jonathan B.

A recent, and somewhat cryptic, tweet sent early in the morning on Saturday March 12, 2022 by Tesla and SpaceX CEO, Elon Musk, has prompted an intense spike in media attention for the billionaire. The subject of the post: a new SpaceX mission, set to launch in April of 2024, with the intended purpose of establishing a colony on the Sun. With critics and media begging for details, Musk held a press conference a week later on March 19, where he explained further details of the project.

When asked about how this recent project will impact his recent efforts to colonize Mars, Musk said that he was setting aside this 2026 goal in order to focus on the Sun project, which is not only shorter term, but could also be more beneficial for humans in the long run. Since the Sun is 207 times larger than Mars, with a significantly more livable environment for humans, the star could provide a larger surface for the rapidly expanding human population. He then presented data analyzed by SpaceX scientists from recent probe operations, showing that the Sun would be a hospitable environment for human life should the Earth fall to the ever-encroaching issue of global warming. While it is slightly warmer on the star than on Earth, the weather conditions are more consistent, with a drop or rise in temperature being unlikely in the near future. This

indicates that current industrial habits of humans, if continued on the Sun colony, wouldn't have the negative environmental impact there as they do on Earth, and that no spacesuits would be required, resulting in a relatively normal life. In another tweet following the conference, Musk posted the specifics of the vessel to be used for this mission, the SpaceX Dragonfire P-ZXV3854R, which is currently in development. Fully equipped with hibernation pods for over 2,000 people, extra deck space, flight attendants, and an onboard casino, resulting in a luxurious ride. Once landed, Tesla robots will help to construct, as Musk has stated, a "real old-fashioned American neighborhood with a modern twist."

Colonizing the sun has prompted discussion among other groups as well, with some questioning an ulterior motive to Musk's project. A leaked image by an anonymous SpaceX employee under the handle @flatearthmartianinvasion revealed scaled alien figures on the surface of the Sun, captured in high quality by SpaceX's probe satellites. Many are wondering whether Musk plans to conquer these beings, or if it is a wise choice to invade their territory at all.

While a surprising and bold statement to be sure, Musk's plans are supported by valid science, and could provide an evolutionary leap for humans. While some of the initial 2,000 colonizers could perish either while in transit to the new Sun colony, or once they arrive, being unaccustomed to the warmer conditions of the sun, the risk, to Musk at least, is worth it, as he intends to be the first one boarding the rocket in April of 2024.

Liquid Water on Mars?

MARSIS, a subsurface radar sounder on the Mars Express orbiter has taken one step closer to its goal. MARSIS is a 40-meter antenna that is intended to look for the telltale signs of liquid water on the Martian surface, and on January 25, 2022, one of these signs arose. Oddly bright reflections detected through the bouncing of radio waves and the analyses of its echoes signified the possibility of liquid water under the poles of Mars. The inherent properties of water result in the reflection of stronger, brighter signals, whereas the radar signal for ice and rock would be much smaller. This data has been critiqued by many scientists due to the fact that the poles are at temperatures drastically below the freezing point of water. The radar signals resulting from clay, salts, and saline ices may also be the sources of the bright basal reflections.

An Italian-led team interpreted the phenomena of these reflections through previously published data, simulations, and laboratory experiments designed to clarify their findings. Geophysicist Dr. David Stillman at the Southwest Research Institute has been at the forefront of this discovery. "The exotic salts that we know exist on Mars have amazing 'antifreeze' properties allowing brines to remain liquid down to -103 degrees Fahrenheit. We studied these salts in our lab to understand how they would respond to radar." Stillman is the world's leading expert on the detection of water in various forms- liquid, ice, or absorbed - on planetary bodies. The concentration of salts in the water makes it more difficult for bonds to form between molecules, thus lowering the freezing point, a phenomenon visible in the salting of roads in the winter.

The unique conditions that which the water beneath the surface finds itself is what results in its persistence as a liquid in spite of sub-zero temperatures. Stillman, who has measured the properties of materials at cold temperatures to detect and characterize subsurface ice, unfrozen water, and the potential for life throughout the solar system, measured the properties of perchlorate brines in an SWRI environmental chamber that produces frigid temperatures in Martian conditions.

Southwest Research Institute geophysicist Dr. David Stillman uncovered oddly bright reflections that signify the presence of liquid water but could also be clay, hydrated salts, or saline ices. The water discovered is a mixture as cold as -145 degrees Fahrenheit and exists between grains of ice or sediment under Mars' south pole. "The research showed that we don't have to have lakes of perchlorate and chloride brines, but that these brines could exist between the grains of ice or sediments and are enough to exhibit a strong dielectric response. This is similar to how seawater saturates grains of sand at the shoreline or how flavoring permeates a slushie, but at -103 degrees Fahrenheit below a mile of ice near the South Pole of Mars," Stillman said. This discovery is a stepping stone for the end to the loneliness that we experience as the only known life on a pale blue dot.


There is controversy between the bridge known as De Hef in Rotterdam, Netherlands, and former CEO of Amazon, Jeff Bezos. The 95-year-old train bridge might be dismantled to let Jeff Bezos' \$485 million yacht through. This has created a lot of controversy with the people of Rotterdam.

One man in particular, Pablo Strörmann, posted an idea on Facebook, to throw rotten eggs at the yacht. This has grown into a massive social media trend with 20,000 people becoming interested in Strörmann's idea. Strörmann shared that he sees the train bridge as a symbol of resurrection after the city was wiped out by Germans during the Rotterdam Blitz in 1940. This bridge was one of the first structures to be restored. According to the NL Times, Strörmann stated, "Normally it's the other way around: If your ship doesn't fit under a bridge, you make it smaller. But when you happen to be the richest person on Earth, you just ask a municipality to dismantle a monument. That's ridiculous." Strörmann makes a very strong argument that Jeff Bezos' yacht should not receive special treatment, considering that the bridge has held strong without problem, except for the Rotterdam Blitz, since 1927. Although Strörmann believes that dismantling this bridge shouldn't take place, he stated that the egging trend began as a joke he had made with his friends and it had gotten, "way out of hand." He did not think that so many people would be interested in throwing eggs at the yacht.

The city has mostly agreed to the bridge dismantling for a variety of reasons. First of all, Bezos offered to pay for the entirety of the process. So, the government definitely wouldn't lose any money due to the removal. Secondly, this action requires workers, meaning that this would create some jobs for the people of Rotterdam, creating income. A Labor Party city councilor in Rotterdam, Dennis Tak, said that he would agree to the offer because of these reasons. There are conflicts with other leaders of Rotterdam. For example, the Rotterdam Historical Society pointed out that city officials had promised to never dismantle the bridge again after completing a major restoration in 2017.

In conclusion, the richest man in the world, Jeff Bezos,

may be scared of eggs. Although the city has agreed to dismantle the bridge, the threat of rotten egg throwing may be enough to keep the 230-foot yacht out of the Koningshaven Channel. This conflict continues to cause controversy.

JAMAICA TAKES HOME MOST MEDALS AT 2022 WINTER OLYMPICS


